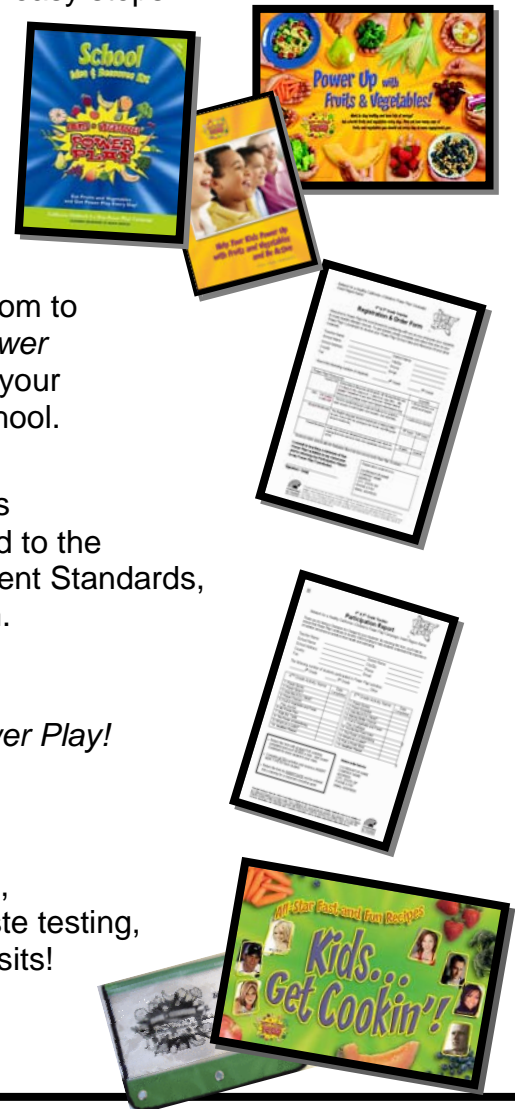




Bring *Power Play!* to your students!
